What is an Insurance Policy?

An insurance policy is a legally binding contract between an insurance company and the person who buys the policy, commonly called the "policyholder", who also is often the person insured. In exchange for payment of a specified sum of money, called the "premium", the insurance company agrees to pay for certain types of loss or damage as specified by the contract.

How does an insurance policy "protect" me?

Insurance policies offer protection against economic loss, that is, loss or damage which can be measured in purely financial terms and compensated by money. The purpose is to place the injured party as close to the same financial position as if the loss had not occurred.

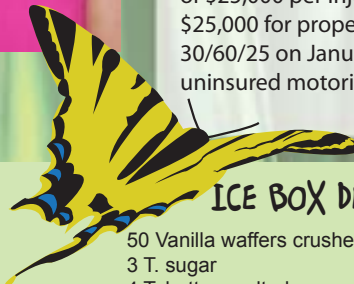
TexasSure Vehicle Insurance Verification, what is it?

The State of Texas implemented a program that allows law enforcement officers and designated state users to immediately verify whether a vehicle is insured. The days of fraudulent or false proof of automobile insurance cards and dropping insurance coverage after receiving a valid insurance card are numbered. Texas law states that a person may not operate a motor vehicle in this state unless financial responsibility is established for that vehicle. Most people do this by buying automobile liability insurance. The law currently requires minimum liability coverage of \$25,000 per injured, \$50,000 for everyone injured in an accident, and \$25,000 for property damage (25/50/25). These limits will increase to 30/60/25 on January 1, 2011. The goal is to reduce the number of uninsured motorists in Texas. (Data taken from TDI)

ICE BOX DESSERT

- 50 Vanilla wafers crushed (about 2 cups)
- 3 T. sugar
- 4 T. butter, melted
- 1 1/2 pkg. cream cheese (or 1 lg. pkg. and 1 sm. pkg.) room temperature
- 3 c. milk
- 1 large pkg. vanilla instant pudding
- 1 12 oz. tub Cool Whip
- Fresh berries of any kind, or frozen berries (thawed)

Mix vanilla wafer crumbs, sugar, and butter together. Press into 9x13 dish. (use the bottom of a glass or a potato masher to press the crumbs down). Bake crust at 350 for 10 min. Cool. Meanwhile, beat cream cheese in large mixing bowl with mixer until creamy. Gradually add milk, mixing well after each addition. Add dry pudding mix; beat 1 more minute. Gently stir in Cool Whip.
